



COWL NECK PONCHO BY LYNDEE BROWN

MACHINE: BULKY

YARN: BERNAT SOFT BOUCLE, LION BRAND HOME SPUN (#5)

PICTURE SHOWS SOFT BOUCLE

TENSION : WHITE WAS 9 (BLUE WAS 9.1)

- 1. CAST ON WITH E-WRAP 40-40 (45-45)**
- 2. KNIT 240 ROWS SHOULD BE ABOUT 58 INCHES ((270) ROWS AND ABOUT 64 INCHES.**
- 3. BIND OFF AROUND 2 GATE PEGS TO KEEP THE BIND OFF LOOSE.**

COWL NECK

- 1. FOLD RECTANGLE IN HALF TO FIND CENTER MEASURE OUT 10 INCHES FROM CENTER 10 IN MARK EACH SIDE WHITE WAS 80 STITCHES. BLUE MEASURE 12 INCHES AND MARK EACH SIDE TOTAL ABOUT 84 STITCHES**
- 2. HANG THE STITCHES BETWEEN THE MARKERS ON THE MACHINE AND AT TENSION 10 KNIT 36 ROWS (50 ROWS_ BIND OFF AROUND 2 GATE PEGS TO KEEP LOOSE**
- 3. HANG STITCHES FROM BOTH SIDES OF THE NECK BACK ON THE MACHINE THIS WILL MAKE A SHOULDER. I BOUND OFF AROUND 2 GATE PEGS. SEW THE COWL TOGETHER AND LIGHTLY STEAM.**
