

# LINDA'S FUN FUR HAT

**Knitting Machine:** Bulky

**Yarn:** Fun Fur (one strand)  
Sport weight yarn (one strand)  
(**or** 2 strands of 2/24)

**Amount:** Slightly more than 1 ball  
of Fun Fur for a ladies size hat

**Use one strand of Fun Fur and  
one strand of sport weight yarn  
together throughout (2 strands of  
2/24 can be substituted for sport  
weight yarn)**



## Ladies Size

1. E-wrap cast-on 70 stitches.
2. RC00: T 7. Knit 4 rows
3. RC04: Change to T 8. Knit 4 rows
4. RC08: Change to T 9. Knit 4 rows
5. RC12: Change to T 10. Knit 33 rows.
6. RC 45: Transfer every other stitch to adjacent needle. Make sure all empty needles are in out of work position. Knit 1 row.
7. RC 46: Change to T 8 and knit 2 rows.
8. RC 48: Change to T 7 and knit 2 rows.
9. RC 50: Sew off with double-eyed needle. Leave a long tail to sew up hat.

## Large Child Size (Med Child Size in parentheses)

1. E-wrap cast on-66 (63) stitches.
2. RC00: T 7. Knit 4 rows
3. RC04: Change to T 8. Knit 4 rows
4. RC08: Change to T 9. Knit 4 rows
5. RC12: Change to T 10. Knit 28 rows.
6. RC 40: Transfer every other stitch to adjacent needle. Make sure all empty needles are in out of work position. Knit 1 row.
7. RC 41: Change to T 8 and knit 2 rows.
8. RC 43: Change to T 7 and knit 2 rows.
9. RC 45: Sew off with double-eyed needle. Leave a long tail to sew up hat.

## **Baby**

1. E-wrap cast on-60 stitches.
2. RC00: T 7. Knit 4 rows
3. RC04: Change to T 8. Knit 4 rows
4. RC08: Change to T 9. Knit 4 rows
5. RC12: Change to T 10. Knit 26 rows.
6. RC 38: Transfer every other stitch to adjacent needle. Make sure all empty needles are in out of work position. Knit 1 row.
7. RC 39: Change to T 8 and knit 2 rows.
8. RC 41: Change to T 7 and knit 2 rows.
9. RC 43: Sew off with double-eyed needle. Leave a long tail to sew up hat.
