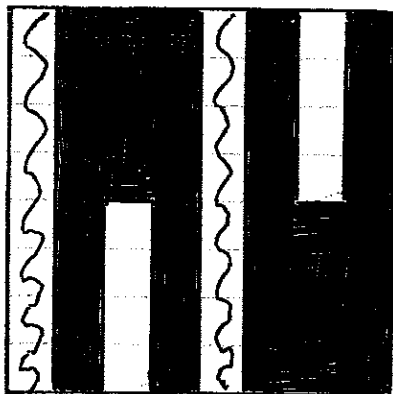


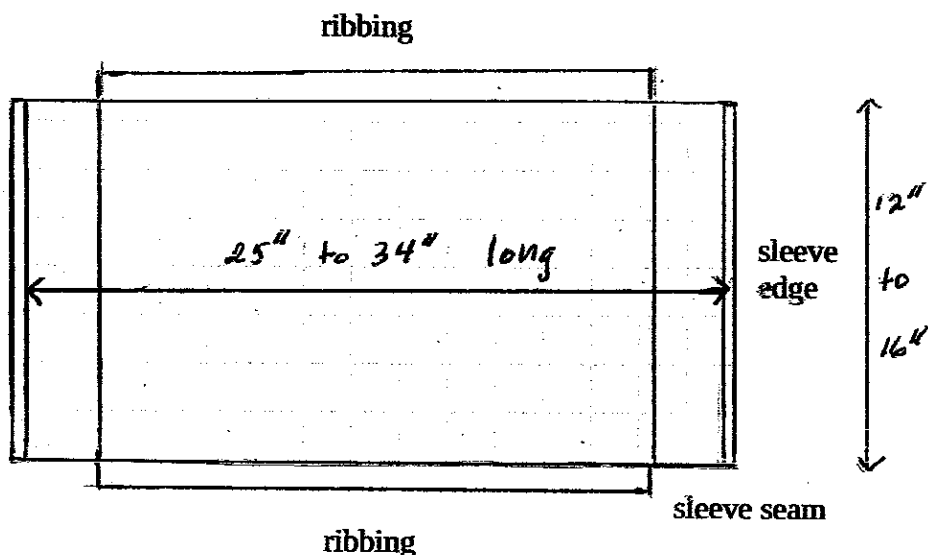
## PHILANTHROPY TUCK LACE SHRUG PATTERN

Standard machine. Knit side is the public side. Yarn: 4 oz. acrylic fingering or sportweight yarn. Tension 10.2 for tuck stitch lace. Tension 7/6 for rib. Gauge: 6.75 stitches per inch, 12 rows per inch.

**Sleeve edge:** Crochet cast on 108 stitches. \*Carriage off hold, knit to the left. With needles in hold, crochet chain behind stitches to the right. Carriage on hold, pass to right.\* Repeat \*to\* 2 more times.

**Stockinet:** Knit 1 row to left. With the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch right of center an empty needle, transfer every 4<sup>th</sup> stitch to an adjacent stitch both right and left of center. Leave empty needles in non-working position:

RC 000. Carriage is on the left. Knit 24 rows. Program the machine for the Tuck Lace Pattern. Select needles for the tuck lace pattern on the next row.

RC 000. Set the carriage to tuck in both directions. Knit 276 rows in pattern. Cancel the tuck stitch.

RC 000. Knit 24 rows stockinet with every 4<sup>th</sup> stitch out of work. Carriage is on the right. Fill in the empty needles with stitches from the purl bumps.

**Sleeve edge:** \*Knit to the left. With the needles in hold, crochet chain behind the stitches. Carriage on hold, pass to the right\*. Repeat \*to\* 3 more times ending on the right. Knit manually LONG stitches across bed to the left. Loop one stitch through the next stitch, from right to left to bind off loosely.

**Ribbing on tuck stitch pattern:** Using a stretchy ribber cast on like the Broken toe, cast on 141 stitches and knit 14 rows in a 1 x 1 rib. Transfer to main bed. With the private side facing you, hang on long edge of the tuck stitch pattern (276 rows) on the 141 needles. Bind off. Repeat for the other long edge.

**Sleeve seams:** Fold in half lengthwise. Right sides together, hang on edge rows, stockinet rows, and the ribbing rows for both sides. Bind off. Repeat on the other end.
