

## Twiddle Muff

Machine: KH260

Tension: 7

Yarn Weight: 4

Fiber: Acrylic

Gauge: 3.75S X 6R

Size: 15"W x 16"L (flat - not round)

### Mock ribbing:

1. Cast on 56 needles with waste yarn
2. Take every other needle out of work
3. Knit with waste yarn a few rows; remove yarn from carriage
4. Set row counter to 0
5. Add yarn for glove
6. Knit 6 rows tension 4
7. Knit 1 row tension 7
8. Knit 6 row tension 4
9. Take every stitch from first row of work and add to empty needles
10. Remove waste yarn
11. Knit a row to secure ribbing

### Glove:

12. Set row counter to 0
13. Continue knitting for 84 rows tension 7
14. Take stitch from every other needle and place in life line using waste yarn; place empty needles in non-working position
15. Knit 6 rows tension 4
16. Knit 1 row tension 7
17. Knit 6 rows tension 4
18. Take stitches from life line and place stitch aligned to each empty needle. Remove waste yarn
19. Knit 1 row tension 7
20. Needle bind off
21. Using mattress stitch, seam the fabric into a tube
22. Attach buttons, ribbons or anything that would be decorative and functional for sensory activities
